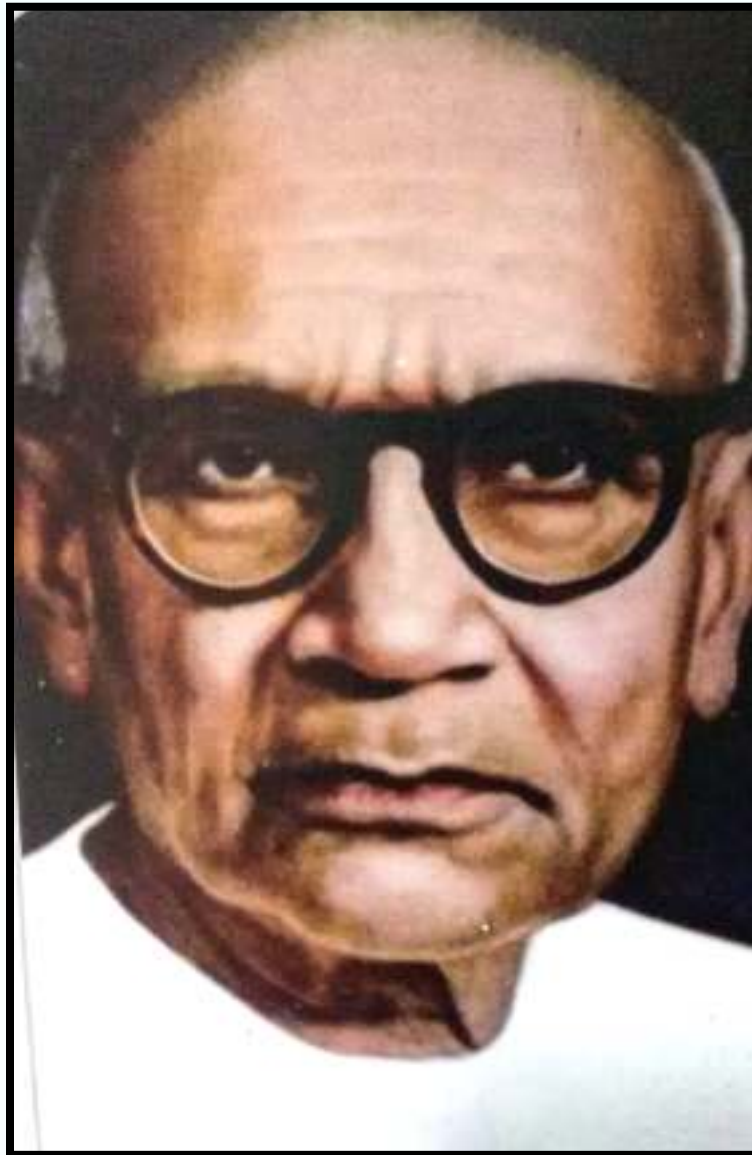
इस सत्र में अपने नव प्रवेशित छात्रों की सुविधा के लिये विभिन्न शैक्षणिक जानकारियों का संकलन कर प्रस्तुत किया जाना विश्वविद्यालय के लिये गौरव का प्रसंग है। यह जानकारी विश्वविद्यालय की कार्य प्रणाली, शैक्षणिक उपादानों तथा आज के परिवेश में छात्रों के उज्ज्वल भविष्य के एक स्तम्भ को प्रदर्शित करता है।

विश्वविद्यालय में स्नातकोत्तर स्तर के सभी पाठ्यक्रम सत्र 2020-21 से ही सी.बी.सी.एस. प्रणाली पर संचालित हैं । सत्र 2021-22 से स्नातक स्तर के सभी तीन वर्षीय पाठ्यक्रमों का संचालन नई राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति 2020 के तहत आरंभ कर दिया गया है । निश्चित ही नई शिक्षा नीति के अंतर्गत संचालित पाठ्यक्रम युवा छात्र-छात्राओं के सर्वांगीण विकास एवं उन्हें रोजगार के अवसर प्रदान करने में महत्वपूर्ण भूमिका निभायेंगे ।

विश्वविद्यालय में रोजगारपरक पाठ्यक्रमों की शुरुआत के साथ-साथ स्थानीय प्रतिभाओं को स्टार्ट-अप के लिये आर्थिक सहयोग भी प्रदान किया जा रहा है । इसके अंतर्गत सुपाड़ी के खिलौने बनाने का प्रशिक्षण उल्लेखनीय है । विगत सत्र से स्थापित इन्क्यूबेशन सेण्टर में छात्र-छात्राओं को प्रशिक्षित कर रोजगार के बेहतर अवसर सुलभ कराये जा रहे हैं । शासकीय वित्तीय सहयोग के संदर्भ में विशेष व्याख्यान भी आयोजित किये जा रहे हैं ताकि छात्रों को अपने खुद के रोजगार स्थापित करने में सहयोग मिल सके ।

विश्वविद्यालय अपनी स्थापना के 54 वर्ष पूर्ण कर चुका है तथा मध्यप्रदेश ही नहीं पूरे देश में अपनी विशिष्ट पहचान बना रहा है । यहां के पुरा छात्र देश के विभिन्न प्रान्तों में महत्वपूर्ण पदों पर आसीन हैं । मुझे आशा है कि विवरणिका में प्रकाशित सामग्री छात्रों के लिये न सिर्फ उपयोगी होगी अपितु संग्रहणीय भी होगी । मैं इसके प्रकाशन हेतु अपनी शुभकामनायें प्रेषित करता हूं ।

About Rewa City

All over the world, Rewa is known as the "land of white tigers" as the first white tiger was found in Rewa. It was named Mohan by the ruling king Maharaja Martand Singh. Mohan's progeny is now spread all over the world. Rewa, located on the central Vindhya Plateau was the capital of the Princely State of Rewa from the beginning of the 17th Century A.D. The name Rewa is derived from 'Reva' the ancient name of the sacred river Narmada. Rewa also had the honour of being the capital of Vindhya Pradesh. Rewa is the only place in the world where beautiful handicrafts are made from beetle nuts (supari). The fineness of the craft is such that joints are not at all visible on the finished work.



At present, Rewa is a divisional head quarter and an important centre for education and culture in Central India. It has the privilege of having the Sainik School, which is the only one in each state. This region is developing fast as an industrial belt with the presence of giants like NTPC, NCL, Jaypee Cement, ACC Cement, Prism Cement, Birla Ericsson for years and due to the entrance of multinational players like Essar Group, Reliance, KJS Cements and others. The establishment of the largest Solar Power Plant in the World and the unique White Tiger Safari in

this region has transformed it into a prominent center of energy and tourism in the state of Madhya Pradesh and Central India. Four-lane connectivity of roads from Satna, Jabalpur, Allahabad & Varanasi has enhanced the pace of business & commercial activities in Rewa. The commissioning of Bansagar Dam Project and fast spread of its canal network in the region is destined to rewrite the fortune of this region.

White Tiger Safari, Mukundpur (16km, 30min), BandhavGarh (160km, 3hrs) and Khajuraho (200km, 4hrs) are the nearby International Tourism centres for Wild Life and Heritage Tourism, respectively; while, Maihar (65km, 90min), Chitrakoot (150km, 3hrs) and Vindhyavasini (250km, 4hrs 30min) are the sacred pilgrimage spots in this region.

The city can be approached by road from Satna which is 52 km from this place and is on Howrah-Bombay route. It can also be reached through Prayagraj & Jabalpur which are connected through four lane roads and are nearly 125 km and a two hours drive and nearly 230 km and three & half hour's drive from this place. Rewa is also well connected by railway network as 11 trains initiate from this place to connect with prominent cities and places. There are direct trains to New Delhi, Mumbai, Bhopal, Indore, Jabalpur, Bilaspur, Nagpur, Kevadia & Rajkot, initiating from this place.





Our University

This university was established on 20th July 1968 as a state university of Madhya Pradesh. The University has been named after a distinguished son of the soil and a freedom fighter Capt. Awadhesh Pratap Singh, a national leader and the first Prime Minister of Vindhya Pradesh. The university was recognized by the UGC in February 1972. The University is a member of the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) and All Commonwealth Association of Universities (ACAU). The University has 13 teaching departments which offer more than 50 professional programmes on self-supporting basis apart from the regular post graduate programmes. We also impart education through nearly 210 affiliated colleges within the University jurisdiction in Anuppur, Rewa, Satna, Shahdol, Sidhi, Singrauli and Umaria districts of Madhya Pradesh. The university also provides education to the people in the remote areas through distance learning mode. Our university is producing world class talent with optimum utilization of limited resources. Under the dynamic leadership of our present Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Rajkumar Acharya the university has set new goals and aspirations for itself and is aiming to achieve newer heights.

University Campus

The university is spread over 250 acres of hilly and green campus. It is located about 5 km. to the north of the main city of Rewa on Sirmour Road. The University buildings include an Administrative Block, Department of Environmental Biology, Physics Department, Chemistry, Mathematics & English Department, Humanities Block, Department of Psychology, Ambedkar Bhawan, Life Long Learning Department, AntarBharti Building, Community Hall, Biotechnology Building, Law & Commerce Building, Directorate of Distance Education Building, MBA Dept., Computer Centre, USIC Building, Library, Guest House, Faculty Hostel, Arjun Building, Gymnasium Hall, Yoga Hall, Women's Common Room, separate building for Bank, an Auditorium and two hostels, one for boys and other for girls. The campus has two separate colonies, one each for teachers and employees of the University. Primary Health Centre Building is also established within the campus. A well-equipped Inter Mediate School is also established in the campus for the children of university employees and nearby locality as a part of the university's social responsibility.

University Administration

The University Court is the supreme governing body. The Executive Council is the Chief Executive body. It consists of the Vice-Chancellor, Secretary to the Govt. of Madhya Pradesh, Education Department or his nominee, three members elected by the Court, two members nominated by the Chancellor, four Principals of Colleges nominated by the Chancellor by rotation according to seniority, and four Deans, nominated by the Chancellor. The Academic Council is the Chief Academic body. His Excellency, the Governor of Madhya Pradesh, is the Chancellor of the University.

The University Court has powers to override the acts of the Executive and Academic Council. The Executive Council, on its part, controls the University funds and also makes regulations. The Academic Council constitutes Faculties and Boards of Studies to prepare papers, syllabi and also recommends ordinances & regulations concerning admission, execution and examination.

Our university is a fine example of excellent management of higher education with limited resources. In spite of low paying capacity of the students, faculty crunch and financial limitations, our university is imparting quality education to students in an exemplary manner. Our students are adorning high positions across the globe. Our university conveys the message that an institution is not made of concrete structures only; it is the spirit that guides the institution which really matters.

Department of Ancient Indian History Culture & Archaeology

This department was established in September, 1984 under the 6th Five Year Plan. Number of teaching post sanctioned one professor, one reader and three Lecturers by the UGC. The department runs PhD and M.A.(A.I.H.C.& Arch.) Programmes as regular programmes while B.A. (Hons) programme is offered as a Self-Supporting Programme (SSP). Two senior professors are working against the sanctioned post while two Guest faculties are working in regular Programmes and three Guest faculty are teaching in B.A. (Hons.) Programmes under SSP. The department invites eminent professors from across the country to deliver Invited Talks to the students.



Tourism Programmes

The study centre for Tourism came into existence in 1991. MBA (Tourism Administration) and BBA (Tourism and Hospitality Management) are job oriented self-financing programmes run by the department. Special emphasis is given on developing the students in Tour and Travel Management, Tourism Marketing, Heritage Management, Hotel and Financial Management. Job training is mandatory for each and every student. Six Guest faculty are working in tourism programmes among them one PhD and one PhD with NET are serving. Most pass out students are employed in various agencies of India and Abroad. Tourism is one of the most job-oriented programmes and a very popular subject in the University.

Gandhian Study Centre: An Ancillary Unit of the Department

This centre was established during the 10th plan period under the able Directorship of Prof. N.P. Pathak, Professor, Department of Business Economics. As the name suggests, the activity of this centre revolves around Gandhi's Philosophy of truth, non-violence and simple life. It organizes programme on the occasions related to Mahatma Gandhi. A series of 150 programmes were celebrated from 2nd October, 2018 to 2nd October, 2019 by Gandhian Study Centre under the canopy of the department. Under the canopy of Business Economics Department several courses are running namely- M.Com. and B.Com. (Hons), BALLB and LLM. Department of Chemistry

This department was established in 1984, with the basic aim to cater to the needs of students of Vindhya Region which is a socially and economically backward part of Central India. This region is particularly rich in natural resources. Our former Prime Minister (Late) Mrs. Indira Gandhi foresighted it as Cement Belt and planned to run "Cement Express" From Delhi to connect Power Capital to the Country "Shaktinagar" in the Singrauli area. Situated in border of UP & MP the region is rich

in natural resources like limestone, bauxite, coal, diamond, granite and iron etc. Based on these resources major industries like cement aluminum coal, (Power) and paper are operating since past fifty year. Chemical Sciences are the backbone of these major industries; Most of such industrial units are in the university jurisdiction.



The department has been recognized by the UGC, New Delhi for its academic pursuits and special assistance under (DRS) has been sanctioned to the department in the year 2006. Despite all natural resources and manpower, the younger generation of the region lacked technical skills and the exploitation of the resources available. Local stalwarts' and academicians felt that by providing proper guidance, quality teaching and technical know-how, this region can be developed and brought in the main stream of the country. With these objectives the then Vice-Chancellor Prof. Hira Lal Nigam, a renowned Inorganic Chemist, took all the pains to establish a Department of Chemistry in this University. Postgraduate teaching and research programme were undertaken by the department to fulfill the aims and goals of the department.

The department runs M.Sc., and Ph.D. courses as regular Programmes. The syllabus of M.Sc. has been revised as the syllabus recommended by UGC New Delhi. We have implemented CBCS pattern as laid down in new Education Policy 2020 of Govt of India. The department also runs M.Sc. (Biochemistry), B.Sc. Hons Chemistry & B.Sc. Hon's Biochemistry Programmes on Self Supporting basis and is going to offer B.Sc. (Pharmaceutical Chemistry) Programme from this session.

The department has received major research projects from DST, CSIR, UGC, AICTE, MPCST etc. It was given DRS by the UGC in 2004. The students are well placed in different institutions/organizations like IIT, NIT, NITTTR, Universities, Govt. PG Colleges, Research Laboratories and even in foreign countries.

The department is also facilitating research activities to colleges. The department is having sophisticated instruments like AA Spectrophotometer, Cyclic Voltammetry, IR, UV spectrophotometer, Flame photometer, Software's and computer facilities for Computer Aided Drug Design. The department has an e-class room, Conference Hall and modern laboratories. Presently MoU has been signed with MPCST, Bhopal (MP).



Department of Computer Application

The department was established in 1985-86 (erstwhile known as Computer Centre), in the university by the University Grants Commission, New Delhi with the aim of providing job-oriented computer courses and employment-oriented programs to the students of Vindhya region. In the beginning the department was headed by Prof. S.P. Agrawal, who contributed immensely to its firm establishment and development. Initially ICIM DRS 300 Mini computer System was installed with other peripheral devices including line printers. The established computer centre was upgraded in year 2000 by the UGC. In the year 2017 the University has renamed computer centre as Department of Computer Application. At present department has two computer labs equipped with latest computers, printers and other peripheral devices. The department conducts training programs for university/college teachers, employees and students, besides computing and software development for the university.



BCA program has been started in the year 2006-2007 on self-supporting basis (Ordinance number 120). Looking to the demand of students the University has started Master of Computer Application (MCA) course in the year 2013-14 (Ordinance number 165). The MCA course got approval from AICTE, New Delhi from session 2015-16. Apart from these courses 12 short term computer courses are also offered as per demand of students (Ordinance number 95). There are 310 students studying in the department in the session 2020-21.

Department of Mathematical Sciences

The department came into existence in September 1984 with its initial name 'Department of Mathematics & Statistics'. The foundation stone of the building where the department came into existence was laid down by the then chief minister of Madhya Pradesh Shri Motilal Vora. However, from April 1999, its name has been changed to be known now onwards as the 'Department of Mathematical Sciences'. Initially Prof. R. B. Misra (Professor & Head), Dr. C. K. Sharma (Reader), Dr. N. P. Singh and Dr. J. P. Singh (Lecturers) joined as faculty members in the year 1985. In 1989, Dr. R. N. Singh joined the department as a lecturer. Dr. (Mrs.) Kavita Shrivastava and Dr. Akhileshwar Prasad were appointed as lecturer in the department in years 1994 and 1996 respectively. Prof. R. B. Misra had been the Vice-Chancellor of Avadh University, Faizabad during 1989-92. Prof. C. K. Sharma served as acting Vice-Chancellor of Awadhesh Pratap Singh University, Rewa in the year 2003.



The department runs M.A./M.Sc., M.Phil. and Ph.D. programs in Mathematics. Currently around one hundred fifty students are studying in the department. The department has made notable research contributions in the areas of Special Functions, General Relativity, Cosmology and Differential Geometry. Researchers of the department have been visiting and interacting with various research institutions of the country. The department received library grant from 'National Board for Higher Mathematics, Mumbai'. More than 250 research papers and articles have been published by the faculty of the department in National/International journals. The research papers of the faculty members are also cited in reference books and journals of high impact factor. Four students of the department have qualified NET/SET examination. Since the inception of the department, more than 45 students have been awarded Ph. D. degree and over 250 students have obtained M. Phil. degree.

The department received international recognition in the year 1987 when it was selected under federation scheme of the "International Centre for Theoretical Physics, Trieste (Italy)" Since then the federation was renewed annually till 1992. It provided rare opportunity to the faculty members and students of the department to visit the I.C.T.P. for the improvement of their knowledge with the financial support offered by the Centre. The department successfully organized the 65th Annual Conference of Indian Mathematical Society during Dec. 20-23 1999. Some of the notable personalities who visited the department from time to time are Prof. Franco Fava (Italy), Prof. P. C. Vaidya, Prof. Nand Lal, Prof. B. B. Sinha, Prof. K. K. Azad, Prof. J. B. Rao, Prof. Nand Kishor, Prof. K. P. Singh, Prof. S. R. Roy, Prof. H. C. Khare, Prof. David Gauld (New Zealand), Prof. A. N. Roy, Prof. T. Pati, Prof. Bill Fieldman (U. S. A.), Prof. U. C. De, Prof. M. A. Pathan, Prof. P. N. Pandey and Prof. S. D. Tripathi et al.

Department of Physics

Rewa being in the near equatorial region, is potentially important for recording and analysis of space data - an extremely important scientific information which is useful in the field of Space Science in general and Space Weather in particular, looking into this prominent feature, A.P.S. University, Rewa initiated step to launch research/teaching activities in this pertinent area of Science and Technology. After due approval from University Grants Commission, New Delhi during the first phase of IV plan i.e., in the year 1975, the seedling was sown in form of Vikram Space Physics Center in the University premises. 18NM64 Super Neutron Monitor facility was established under the astute leadership of **Late Prof. S.P. Agrawal** - a Ph.D. student of noted & eminent Scientist **Prof. U.R Rao** to record /analyze space data. This center gradually augured and ultimately this nucleus transformed into full-fledged Physics Department in the year 1982. Late Prof. R.L Singh, Prof. S.K.Nigam, Prof. D.P. Tiwari and Dr. V.N. Pandey joined the department to groom the aspiring students. It is worth mentioning here that Prof. S.P.Agrawal and Prof. S.K. Nigam served as acting Vice-Chancellor of this University and Prof. R.L. Singh as Vice-chancellor of G.G.D. University, Bilaspur. With the induction of Prof. A.P. Mishra and Prof. S.L. Agrawal in this department in 1990, research activities augured in the field of Space Science and Materials Science respectively. Prof Ajay Saxena joined in 1996 to give pace to teaching activities.



At the terminal end of XI five-year plan, Department has acquired advanced instruments like Powder XRD, SEM etc. The department offers MSc Physics and PhD Physics Programmes. Over 120 students have been awarded Ph.D. degree since inception and presently a number of students are engaged in Ph.D. Programme. Around 400 research publications are the outcome of Ph.D. Programme with the help of existing facilities during the last four decades.

Apart from this under its canopy, the department runs MSW & BSW Programmes in Study Centre for Social Work, MBA (IR&PM) in Study Centre for Industrial Relations & Personnel Management and Diploma in Yoga Education (DYEd) & M.A. Yoga in Yoga Kendra.

जवाहरलाल नेहरू नीति शोध केंद्र

जवाहरलाल नेहरू नीति शोध केंद्र की स्थापना जुलाई 1988 में हुई। केंद्र का मुख्य उद्देश्य राष्ट्रीय और विशेषकर प्रादेशिक सार्वजनिक नीतियों से संबंधित शोध कार्य को बढ़ावा देना था। इस दृष्टि से केंद्र ने नीति शोध में अंतर्विधायी एमफिल कोर्स का सफल संचालन 1988 से किया और विभिन्न नीतियों पर केंद्रित व्याख्यान, ओरियंटेशन प्रोग्राम, संगोष्ठी और विभिन्न कार्यशाला का आयोजन किया। केंद्र द्वारा प्रतिष्ठित **स्वर्गीय उमा परौहा स्मृति व्याख्यानमाला** का आयोजन किया जाता रहा है और केंद्र द्वारा समाज विज्ञान के क्षेत्र में उपयोगी एवं प्रतिष्ठित शोध जर्नल— **'इंडियन जर्नल ऑफ पॉलिसी स्टडीज'** का प्रकाशन किया जा रहा है।

केंद्र ने विभिन्न सार्वजनिक नीतियों पर केंद्रित समाज विज्ञान के दृष्टिकोण से कई शोध अध्ययन संपादित किए हैं जिनमें प्रमुख रूप से जनजाति विकास, आरक्षण नीति, शिक्षा नीति, पंचायती राज एवं ग्रामीण विकास, आर्थिक एवं औद्योगिक विकास, आवास नीति, स्वास्थ्य नीति, मतदाता जागरूकता एवं महिला एवं बाल विकास पर केंद्रित विभिन्न विषयों पर एम सील शोधार्थियों ने शोध अध्ययन कार्य संपादित किए हैं।

सत्र 2020–21 में केंद्र द्वारा तीन राष्ट्रीय वेबीनार का आयोजन किया गया। प्रथम राष्ट्रीय वेबीनार का विषय — **'उच्च उच्च शिक्षा के समग्रता के संदर्भ में राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति'** था वहीं दूसरा राष्ट्रीय वेबीनार आजादी के अमृत महोत्सव के अंतर्गत आयोजित किया गया जिसका विषय— **'भारत की आजादी में समाचार पत्र पत्रिकाएं एवं पत्रकारों की भूमिका'** था तृतीय राष्ट्रीय वेबीनार का विषय— **'ग्रामीण विकास में जन सहभागिता'** था जिसमें मुख्य अतिथि के रूप में प्रसिद्ध समाजसेवी श्री अन्ना हजारे जी का उद्बोधन हुआ। सभी तीनों वेबीनार के संयोजक केंद्र के संचालक प्रोफेसर राजीव दुबे एवं आयोजन सचिव श्री नलिन कुमार दुबे थे।

CENTRAL FACILITIES

Central Library

The University has a Central Library. A rich collection of books and journals is available in the library. The library also has an e-Library Section where access to various online journals, books and other publications is made available to students, research scholars and faculty members. Attempts are regularly made to procure standard publications. Apart from this each teaching department has its own departmental library.

University Publications

The university has two regular publications; Pratibimb & Vindhya Bharti. Pratibimb is a quarterly Newsletter while Vindhya Bharti is an annual multi-disciplinary Research Journal.

Hostel Facility

The university campus has one hostel each for boys and girls studying in the University Teaching Departments. The availability of seats is limited and the quota is allotted to every department. Interested candidates apply for accommodation in the hostel in the prescribed form through proper channel.

University Guest House

University has a well-furnished Guest House in the campus. The accommodation and catering is provided to the guests of the university at a nominal cost.

University Stadium & Sports

The University Stadium is centrally located in the city. It has facilities for Cricket, Volleyball, Basketball, Kho Kho, Kabbadi and Wrestling. There is a football ground, Gymnasium Hall & Yoga Hall in the main Campus. Every year university's teams participate in various inter-university games and sports competitions like athletics, basketball, badminton, chess, cricket, khokho, hockey, hand ball, volley ball, wrestling, judo, karate etc. The desired information regarding eligibility, selections and schedules can be taken from the Department of Physical Education & Sports.

University Auditorium

University has an auditorium in the campus in the name of its founder Vice Chancellor Pt. Shambhu Nath Shukla. The auditorium is furnished with all the necessary facilities. It has a seating capacity of more than 500 persons.

NSS

A unit of National Service Scheme (NSS) is functional in the campus. Students who are admitted in the University Teaching Departments can join this unit to participate in the activities related to plantation, cleanliness, sanitation, rural development etc.

Incubation Centre

The University has established an Incubation Centre for promoting New Ideas and Start Ups in the region. The centre will incubate the business ideas with relevance and fitment to the local expertise, uniqueness and market demands. Initially the centre will provide training and support for Start Ups related to Beetle Nut Toys, Handmade Soaps & Sanitizers and Mobile Apps. In future, the university is planning to promote the Start Ups related to Solar Panels, Processed Food & Aryurvedic Medicines and Handlooms.



Directorate of Skill Development

The Directorate of Skill Development has been established in the university to enhance employability of the students by offering them various Certificate Programmes in skill development as per the needs of the industry and the society. These Certificate Programmes will be run in different teaching departments of the university.

Study Centre of Indira Gandhi National Open University

The Study Centre of Indira Gandhi National Open University, New Delhi is well established in the university campus. Prof. R. N. Singh is the Co-ordinator of this Study Centre. The study centre provides learning opportunities in various courses of IGNOU. Large numbers of students are getting opportunities to study general and specialized programmes of IGNOU through this study centre.

Model Career & Skill Centre (MCSC)

University has done a MoU with Confederation of Indian Industries (CII) and established a Model Career & Skill Centre (MCSC) in the campus to provide placement opportunities to the students of this region. Job Fairs and Skill Training Programmes are regularly organized in the campus by centre.

Bank & Post Office

A branch each of Indian Bank and Post Office is operating in the university campus for the convenience of students and staff. All the banking and postal facilities and services are available in these branches.

Primary Health Centre

A Primary Health Centre is established in the campus with all facilities related to first aid for any kind of emergency requirements.





GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Admission Procedure

Admission to most of the UG and PG Programmes are given at university level on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examination. The guidelines of Higher Education Department, Madhya Pradesh, Bhopal (MP) are strictly followed. Admission to MBA Programme is done through CMAT conducted by AICTE usually in the month of February, every year. Admission Counseling is done by Director, Technical Education, Madhya Pradesh, Bhopal (MP). Admission to NCTE approved BEd, BPEd and MPEd Programmes are done centrally by Higher Education Department, Madhya Pradesh, Bhopal (MP).

Provisional Admission List

List of provisionally admitted candidates will be displayed on the Notice Board of the concerned Department/Study Centre from time to time. The applicants are required to be in constant touch with the department to know about their admission status. In case, a candidate misses to report in the given time and fails to take admission, his/her candidature will be considered in the next list if the vacancies are available.

Reservations

Reservations to SC/ST/OBC, Girls, Ex-Military, Freedom Fighters, and University Employees etc. will be given as per the University and State Government guidelines/rules. The candidates claiming admission against any Reserved Category Seats should submit, along with their application form an attested copy of the certificate from the competent authority as per the State Government norms.

Attendance Requirements

Each candidate will have to complete the minimum attendance requirements for appearing in the semester examination. His/her examination form will not be forwarded if he/she fails to get a minimum of 75% attendance in the classes of each semester.

Prevention of Ragging

Ragging is totally banned in the University Campus and outside. Each and every student who gets admission in the university must ensure that he is not involved in ragging of other students directly or indirectly. Newly admitted students must immediately bring in the knowledge of the university administration any such incidence of ragging with them. Strict disciplinary action will be taken against any such student who is reported and found indulging in ragging the other student.

Youth Festival

Every year Youth Festival is organized to showcase the talent and skills of students. It helps in the overall development of the students. As per the directives of the Government, Youth Festival is organized at four levels; Inter Class- College Level (UTD), Inter College- District level, Inter District- University Level and Inter University- State Level. In all, twenty-two competitive events related to academics, dance, singing, theatre and fine arts are organized in the Youth festival at every level. The calendar of the Youth Festival is declared by Higher Education Department, Government of Madhya Pradesh.

MP Online

The admission, examination and all other applications related to TC, Migration, Degree etc. are processed through MP Online.

Cashless Transaction

Cash transactions are not allowed in the university, all the transactions are done through MP Online, NEFT, RTGS and Bank Demand Drafts.
