## An invited lecture on "Health and Hygiene for Young Girls" by Dr. Gunjan Goswami Organized by Department of Business Administration in collaboration with NDLI Club

Dr. Gunjan Goswami began the session by shedding light on the symptoms of PCOS and the potential future risks associated with it. The gathering was highly interactive, allowing students to ask questions regarding both current and prospective issues related to PCOS. Dr. Goswami also provided valuable advice on how to mitigate these problems.

She emphasized the significant influence of our daily routines on our overall health and well-being, urging attendees to be mindful of their daily habits. As part of the recommended remedies, Dr. Goswami highlighted the importance of activities like Surya namaskar (sun salutations), Pranayama (breathing exercises), and maintaining a healthy diet. He also stressed the need to minimize the consumption of junk food.

Dr. Goswami challenged long-standing conservative traditions and refuted their scientific viewpoints, such as the belief that women should not visit temples during their menstrual periods. She explained that women are embodiments of power, and this power flows upwards. Temples, being places of divine energy or Shakti, also possess their own energy. During menstruation, blood flow in women moves in the opposite direction, which, when considered from a scientific perspective, results in opposing magnetic fields. This misalignment of energies and magnetic fields can lead to hormonal imbalances and negatively impact women's health. Therefore, this could be one of the reasons behind the tradition of refraining from temple visits during periods.
