

The Administrative Departments of the University

- 1. **Establishment**: Ms. Teeneshwari Dhruv, Departmental Head. This department looks after the appointment, promotion and disciplinary activities of employees, officers and teachers.
- 2. Administration: Dr. Neerja Namdeo, Departmental Head. The work of this department is related to the act of the university, ordinance and regulation, the conduct of Executive Council and its proceedings and the work related to the university court.
- 3. **Academic:** Mrs. Pushpanjali Ajnare, Departmental Head. The work of this department is related to the academic council, the standing committee of the Academic Council, Research Degree Committee and Board of Studies.
- 4. **Development :** Ms. Teeneshwari Dhruv, Departmental Head. This department is related to the affiliation of the colleges and the renewal of the affiliation. It also looks after the university's dealing with the University Grant Commission and the management of minor and major research projects, unassigned grant and other types of financial aids.
- 5. **Finance:** Shri R.K. Prajapati, Departmental Head. All payments are made through this department. It also keeps the cheques and the drafts.







- 6. **Store:** Shri Babulal Saket, Departmental Head. This department buys stationary and all other things of daily use and distributes it to the different departments of the university.
- 7. **Students' Welfare**: Prof. Atul Pandey Dean, Students Welfare looks after various students related welfare activities in the campus. These activities include initiating and monitoring the admission of students in the University Campus, organizing and participation in Youth Festivals, facilitating scholarships to students, organizing the elections/nomination of office bearers and members in students council as per the directives of the state government and university administration, insurance of students, conducting medical checkups and vaccination camps, conducting various events of state, national and international importance. Every year, Youth Festivals are conducted at College, District, University and State levels, encompassing twenty three competitive events on academics, fine arts, music and theatre are conducted for the overall development of the students. Scholarships are given to meritorious students, weaker section students and reserve category students under various schemes of the government and the university. Apart from these scholarships, the Dean, Students Welfare is also nodal officer for UGC- JRF & SRF Scholarships to the research scholars. DSW disseminates information to the students and teaching staff regarding various national and state level competitive events related to academic and cultural activities.

Dean, Students Welfare act as bridge between students and university administration to expedite the solution to any students related problem, grievances and demands. The DSW also ensures formation of Anti-Ragging Committees and Grievance Redressal Committees for University Teaching Departments and also at University level for affiliated colleges. Dean, Students Welfare is also the authorized officer to handle and resolve the CM Helpline complaints at level 4, as per the directives of the honourable Vice-chancellor.

Presently, Prof. Atul Pandey is the Dean, Students Welfare. Prof. Pandey is a known academician in management education in central India. He is Professor & Head of the Department of Business Administration. He has 28 years of teaching and research experience. Prof. Pandey has been Dean, Faculty of Management Studies and Member of the Executive Council of the University for two terms.

The election of the student council, the management of the youth festivals, the distribution of scholarship and other activities related to the welfare of the students are managed by this department

Scheme of Student's Welfare: All the students of the university are insured so that in times of need the students may be helped. Apart from this, the department informs the students of all schemes of the govt. and the university grants commission. It receives applications and distributes scholarships.

- 8. College Development Council: Prof. N.P. Pathak There are total number of 248 colleges (63 Government Colleges, 177 Private Colleges and 08 Autonomous Colleges) affiliated to Awadhesh Pratap Singh University, Rewa at present. The office of the DCDC deals with the matters related to affiliations and approval of the opening of new colleges. The fresh appointments of the faculty are also made through this office. It plans for the integration of the affiliated colleges and provides them the required necessary help and guidance when ever required on the whole it acts as intermediary between the University and its affiliated colleges. The college development council reviews the implementations of various programmes and activities at regular intervals. The office keeps a close contact with the colleges with a view to help them in their proper development, selection of teachers, student amenities, proper utilization of grants etc. The inspection of the affiliated colleges is done by the committees constituted by the Honourable Vice Chancellor of the University. The DCDC does the overall liaisoning between the University and affiliated colleges. The College Development Council does the liaisoning between the university and the affiliated government and non-government colleges.
- 9. **Examination Section :** Dr. Neerja Namdeo, Departmental Head. The work of this department is related to announcement of the examination results, preparation and distribution of mark sheet and collection of statistics. **Controller of Examination :** Dr. Rajkumar Soni.
- 10. **Confidential Section:** Shri Babulal Saket, Departmental Head. The coding and decoding of answer sheets, printing of examination material and mark sheets and conducting the revaluation of answer sheets is the main activity of this department.







- 11. **Computer Centre:** Dr. P.K. Rai, Departmental Head. The university has its own computer centre that has prepared the university website and has maintained it. It also prepares the annual and the semester examination results and uploads them on the website.
- 12. SC/ST Cell: Miss Neerja Namdeo, Departmental Head. This cell looks after the interest of the scheduled caste and tribes students.

School of Environmental Biology

Departmental Profile

This department is one of the oldest teaching departments of the university established in the year 1977. The department has an excellent infrastructure, laboratories equipped with highly sophisticated instruments like Scanning Electron Microscope (SEM), High Pressure Liquid Chromatography (HPLC), Gas liquid Chromatography (GLC), Atomic Absorption Spectrophotometer, UV-VIS Spectrophotometer, PCR Machine (Thermal Cycler), Deep freezer (-80°C), Gel Documentation System, Air & Water Quality monitoring equipments, Tissue Culture Unit etc.

This department provides research facilities in the field of Pollution & Toxicology, Conservation Biology, EIA, Forest Ecology, Molecular Biology, Applied Microbiology, Biotechnology etc. Recently, the Department of Higher Education, Govt. of Madhya Pradesh has given the status of "Department of Excellence" to this department of the university. More than two thousand research papers have been published by the researchers of this department since its inception. Similarly, more than 500 students have been awarded the degree of Doctor of Philosophy in various fields of Environmental Biology.



This department has organized a one-day seminar on thesis writing and plagiarism checking in collaboration with IISC, Allahabad, funded by UGC for research scholars. In addition, many events of this department have achieved the goal of spreading knowledge and developing practical aptitude among rural and tribal students of Vindhyan region.

This department is also involved in social awareness programs in which the message is imparted to the society for conservation of environment and natural resources. Similar to the previous year, this year too, the department organized a one-day seminar on "World Environment day 5th June 2022" that illustrated the importance of environment among the students and society.

Department of Chemistry

Prof. R.N.Patel, Prof. & Head

The Department of Chemistry was established in 1984. The then, Vice-Chancellor Professor HLN internationally known Professor of Chemistry, established a few teaching departments in the university Tu foundation stone of the building where this department came into existence was laid down by the then Chief Minis of Madhya Pradesh Shri Motilal Vora, Professor S.S.Doosaj, retired professor of Chemistry in Model Science Colle was asked to take care of the newly established department. Soon the appointments were made in 1984. Professor Tandey, Dr KC Mathur, Dr. Vijay K. Agrawal and Dr. Archna Pandey joined as founder faculty members The department started its academic activities from the building of Environmental Biology in the initial phase and later shilled in 1000 to the existing building. In the year 1990 Dr. D.S. Pandey from IIT Kanpur joined this department and worked till he was offered Professor position in BHU, Department of Chemistry got recognition from MP Council of Science & Technology as Centre of Excellence considering the academic achievements of the department in a short span of time

The department, besides the ongoing M.Sc, Chemistry teaching, launched M.Phil and M.Sc. Biochemistry courses looking into ongoing developments in the field of Science & Technology and the need of the hour. In the year 1994, Chemistry Department was entrusted the responsibility to start Personal Contact Programs for pollution and pharmacy related distance mode courses. Later on M.Sc, course in Environmental Chemistry and M.Phil Biochemistry course were also introduced in the department. Currently this department is running M.Sc. Chemistry, M.Sc. Biochemistry, M.Phil. Chemistry, M.Phil. Chemical Sciences, M.Phil. Biochemistry and Ph.D. programms. In the Golden Jubilee Year of the university the department has introduced a new undergraduate program B.Sc. Hons. Biochemistry for the benefit of students of the region. The department is also running B.Sc.Chemistry programme under N.E.P.2020

The Department of Chemistry is known for its contribution in the field of research with financial support from Department of Science and Technology, DRDO, CSIR, University Grants Commission, AICTE and Madhya Pradesh Council of Science and Technology (MPCST) for research proposals which were submitted by faculty members to these agencies from time to time. The department received DRS project from the University Grants Commission in 2004. The faculty members are invited from time to time to present their research findings in different counctries which include Great Britain, USA, Japan, Romania, Indonesia and Germany. One of the faculty members, Prof. R.N. Patel has been conferred with Yadunapalli Memorial award by Indian Chemical Society, Kolkata in the year 2007, Apart from this MP Young Scientist Awards have also been received by young researchers of the department. Chemistry department has the distinction of organizing a number of conferences and seminars including 29th Annual Convention of Chemistry of Indian Chemical Society in the year 1992 with participation of distinguished academicians.

Some of the notable personalities who visited the department from time to time include Prof. L.D.Dave, Prof. C.L. Khetrapal, Prof. D. Banerjee, Prof. R.C. Paul, Prof. R.C. Mehrotra, Prof. Girjeh Govil, Prof. R.P. Rastogi, Prof. R.P. Singh, Prof. S.P.Gupta, Prof. P.C. Gupta, Prof. N.K.Kaushik, Prof. S.S.Katiyar, Prof. U.C. Agrawal, Prof. M.P. Singh, Prof. T.C. Sharma, Prof.A.K.Saxena, Prof. E.B. Singh, Prof. M.M. Bokadia, Prof. P.V. Khadikar, Prof.V.K.Saxena, Prof. Lallan Mishra, Prof.S.S.Sandhu, Prof. N.Ganesh, Prof.N.S.Gajbhiye, Prof. N.Singh, Prof. N.B. Singh, Prof. R.K.P.Singh and Prof. Rajiv Jain. Some of these academicians stayed for long durations to contribute to the enhancement of academic environment in the department. Collaborative researches have also been undertaken by the faculty members with Delhi University, IIT Kanpur, CDRI Lucknow, IIT Indoro, IIT Mumbai. University of Allahabad etc. Foreign collaborations were also undertaken by faculty members.

The faculty members are also members of the National academic bodies viz. Indian Chemical Society, National Academy of Sciences India, Indian Science Congress, Council of Chemists etc. Around 1000 research papers and articles have been published by the faculty in National/International journals. The research papers of the faculty members are also cited in













reference books and jouranals of high impact factor. About ten student have qualified NET/SLET examination. More than 125 students have been awarded Ph.D. degree and over 300 students have obtained M.Phil. degree. Ten students are working in countries like USA, Canada, Australia, South Korea etc.

Prof. R.N. Patel has been actively involved in studying Coordination Chemistry. He has actively collaborated with Department do Quimica Inorganica, Facultad de Framacia Universidad de Granada, Spain. Department of Physics

Rewa being in the near equatorial region, is potentially important for recording and analysis of space data — an extremely important scientific information which is useful in the field of Space Science in general and Space Weather in particular, Looking into this prominent feature, A.P.S. University, Rewainitiated step to launch research/teaching activities in this pertinent area of Science and Technology. After due approval from University Grants Commission, New Delhi during the first phase of IV plan i.e. in the year 1975, the seedling was sown in form of Vikram Space Physics



Center in the University premises. 18NM64 Super Neutron Monitor facility was established under the astute leadership of Late Prof. S.P. Agrawal – a Ph.D. student of noted & eminent Scientist Prof. U.R Rao to record /analyze space data. This center gradually augured and ultimately this nuclei transformed into full fledged Physics Department in the year 1982. Late Prof. R.L Singh, Prof. S.K.Nigam, Prof. D.P. Tiwari and Dr. V.N. Pandey joined the department to groom the aspiring students. It is worth mentioning here that Prof. S.P.Agrawal and Prof. S.K. Nigam served as acting Vice-Chancellor of this University and Prof. R.L. Singh as Vice-chancellor of G.G.D. University, Bilaspur. With the induction of Prof. A.P. Mishra and Prof. S.L. Agrawal in this department in 1990, research activities augured in the field of Space Science and Materials Science respectively. Prof Ajay Saxena joined in 1996 to give pace to teaching activities.

The department has a distinct identity of its own, M.Sc., M.Phil. and Ph.D. are the courses run by the Department and currently there are 135 students studying in this Department. The learned Professors and researchers of the Department have been associated with the reputed research laboratories in India and Abroad. Department has organized a number of National Conferences, Refresher Courses and Scholarly lectures of notable physicist. Physics Department has also been recognized as Center of Excellence by Department of Higher Education, M.P. State Government in 2014. Three major and five minor research projects funded by UGC, CSIR, MPCST and Space Department, Government of India have been completed in the Department. The alumni of the Department have occupied prestigious positions in different organizations like National Meteorological Lab, BARC and National Electronics Organization. Space Physics and Materials Science are the major area of research. About 120 students have been awarded Ph.D. Degree from this Department.

Department of Physics initiated its research activities in the thrust area of Space Science after the establishment of Vikram Space Physics Center. Later on, from the year 1990 it added another research dimension as Solid State Ionics – a specialized area of Materials Science. Right at the onset of Vikram Space Physics Center, a Super Neutron Monitor facility was established which was provided by PRL Ahmedabad to record space data and thus pursue research activities in this Field.

At the terminal end of XI five year plan, Department has acquired advanced instruments like Powder XRD, SEM etc. Over 120 students have been awarded Ph.D. degree since inception and presently number of students are engaged in Ph.D. Programme. Around 400 research publications are the outcome of Ph.D. program with the help of existing facilities during the last four decades.

Department of Mathematical Sciences

The department came into existence in September 1984 with its initial name 'Department of Mathematics & Statistics'. The foundation stone of the building where the department came into existence was laid down by the then chief minister of Madhya Pradesh Shri Motilal Vora. However, from April 1999, its name has been changed to be known now onwards as the 'Department of Mathematical Sciences'. Initially Prof. R. B. Misra (Professor & Head), Dr. C. K. Sharma (Reader), Dr. N. P. Singh and Dr. J. P. Singh (Lecturers) joined as faculty members in the year 1985. In 1989, Dr. R. N. Singh joined the department as a lecturer. Dr. (Mrs.) Kavita Shrivastava and Dr. Akhileshwar Prasad were appointed as lecturer in the department in years 1994 and 1996 respectively. Prof. R. B. Misra had been the Vice-Chancellor of Avadh University, Faizabad during 1989-92. Prof. C. K.



Sharma served as acting Vice-Chancellor of Awadhesh Pratap Singh University, Rewa in the year 2003.

The department runs M.A./M.Sc., M.Phil. and Ph.D. programs in Mathematics. Currently around one hundred fifty students are studying in the department. The department has made notable research contributions in the areas of Special Functions, General Relativity, Cosmology and Differential Geometry. Researchers of the department have been visiting and interacting with various research institutions of the country. The department received library grant from 'National Board for Higher Mathematics, Mumbai'. More than 250 research papers and articles have been published by the faculty of the department in National/International journals. The research papers of the faculty members are also cited in reference books and journals of high impact factor. Four students of the department have qualified NET/SET examination. Since the inception of the department, more than 45 students have been awarded Ph. D. degree and over 250 students have obtained M. Phil. degree.

The department received international recognition in the year 1987 when it was selected under federation scheme of the "International Centre for Theoretical Physics, Trieste (Italy)" Since then the federation was renewed annually till 1992. It provided rare opportunity to the faculty members and students of the department to visit the I.C.T.P. for the improvement of their knowledge with the financial support offered by the Centre. The department successfully organized the 65th Annual Conference of Indian Mathematical Society during Dec. 20-23 1999. Further substantial improvement in parallel computing and Interdisciplinary research in the Dept. of Computer Science has been done.

5. Library & E-library

The Department of Computer Science has its own departmental library to cater the partial need of students. However, Central Library has substantial number of reference books in the field of computer science. Most recent books are continuously added in the Central library through UGC funds. For effective learning, other than conventional Chalk & talk lecture method, teachers use latest modern technologies for teaching. NPTEL/MOOCS video lectures based on syllabus have been compiled and made available offline in the Department. As per requirement virtual classes are organized for students to watch these videos. Department encourages use of open software, Amrita Virtual labs, Google Colab etc for Laboratory.

7. Research Activities:

The research work in Parallel Computing, Machine Learning, Data Mining and Computational Biology has been explored to address the problems in the related fields. Quality research papers have been published and presented



जिला सीधी (वर्ष 1992) एवं पड़ोखर जिला रीवा (वर्ष 1994) में पुरातात्विक उत्खनन कार्य किया गया। विकास क्रम में अधोसंरचना बढ़ने के साथ—साथ निरन्तर सर्वेक्षण कार्यों से प्राप्त सामग्री से विभाग में एक विशिष्ट श्लेणी का संग्रहालय स्थापित है। जिसमें पुरातात्विक सम्पदाओं का जैव एवं वनस्पति जीवाश्म संरक्षित है। विन्ध्य क्षेत्र की प्रागैतिहासिक एवं शैलचित्र कला मानव के उद्भव एवं विकास को व्यक्त करने के लिये चित्र भित्ति पट्टिका के रूप में प्रदर्शित है। वर्तमान में विभाग में स्नातकोत्तर (एम.ए., एम.फिल एवं पी—एच.डी.) के पाठ्यक्रम संचालित हैं। विभाग में अब तक 60 शोधार्थियों ने पी—एच.डी. एवं एक छात्र द्वारा डी.लिट्. उपाधि प्राप्त की है। वर्ष 2009 में विन्ध्य के शैलचित्रों पर अन्तर्राष्ट्रीय शोध संगोष्ठी का आयोजन किया गया था। विभाग में इसरो द्वारा अनुदान प्राप्त डिक्टेटिंग लोकेटिंग आइडेन्टीफाई एण्ड डाकूमेन्टेशन आफ मानुमेंट्स एण्ड स्टडीज आफ द ईस्टर्न विन्ध्यांज पर शोध परियोजना पूर्ण की गयी। विभाग में पुरातात्विक संग्रहालय नई साज—सज्जा के साथ विद्यार्थियों एवं शोधार्थियों के लिये खोला गया। विगत 31 वर्षो में विभाग ने रीवा, सतना, सीधी, शहडोल, उमरिया आदि जिलों का पुरातात्विक सर्वक्षण कार्य किया जिसमें पुरातात्विक महत्व के शैलचित्र, स्तूप, मंदिर एवं ऐतिहासिक पुरास्थल प्रकाश में आये हैं, इनमें रीवा जिले के डूंडी गढ़ी का बौद्ध स्तूप, रेही का मंदिर, सतना जिले का गिद्धैला पहाड़, धौंसड़ा, बरौंधा, खोही, चौरेही, मरबा पाथर (मझगवां) के शैलचित्र, उमरिया जिले का मानपुर स्तूप, सीधी जिले का बौद्धा डॉड बौद्ध स्तूप प्रमुख हैं। विभाग द्वारा अब तक तीन पुरा स्थलों का पुरातात्विक उत्खनन का कार्य किया गया है। वर्ष 2014 में विभाग के आचार्य प्रो. महेश चन्द्र श्रीवास्तव ने वर्ल्ड रॉक आर्ट सोसायटी सम्मेलन में विश्वविद्यालय के प्रतिनिधि के रूप में संयुक्त राज्य अमेरिका में अपना शोध पत्र प्रस्तुत किया। विभाग के वरिष्ठ आचार्य प्रो. सी.डी. सिंह की दो पुस्तकं रंज अर्तिनिधि के रूप में संयुक्त राज्य अमेरिका में अपना शोध पत्र प्रस्तुत किया। विभाग के वरिष्ठ आचार्य प्रो. सी.डी. सिंह की दो पुस्तकं

School of Studies in Business Economics

The School of Studies in Business Economics was established in March, 1979, under the able leadership of our founder Prof. V.C. Sinha, Awadhesh Pratap Singh, University, Rewa. This is the Second University in India (the first being Delhi University) and the First in the State which had introduced Business Economics as Post-Graduate Programme. There has been a long standing demand by various organizations for trained graduates who have a sound background of economic principles and their applications in day-to-day life. The study of Business Economics develops the basic concepts used for decision making for both short and long run planning. It also examines the



relationships useful in predicting the consequences of decisions and effects of economic environment on the behavioral pattern of firms.

Teaching:

The teaching in the department is lecture-based. However, seminars and discussions take place as and when required. The principal discipline of study includes: Micro Economics, Business Environment and Business Policy, Statistics, International Economics, Economics of Growth, Planning & Project Evaluation, Financial Management, Personnel Management & Industrial Relations, Marketing Management & Research, General Economics, Indian Economic Problems and Research Methodology and dissertation/project report.

Library, Laboratories and Equipments:

There are approximately 3000 books related to the subject in the Central Library. Apart from this the Department has a U.G.C. Library which contains 1086 books. Besides this, we have a Departmental Association through which some text books were purchased in the past. The department has 05 Computers, 01 Over Head Projector, V.C.R., Photocopier, one Slide Projector, T.V., L.C.D Projector and a Smart Board.

A popular lecture series was launched by the department from session 2012 onwards. Learned Professors from various universities and organization have delivered their lectures on current economy issues like G.S.T., Demonetization, population dividend, Cashless Economy and Twenty Five Years of the Globalization of Indian Economy. विश्वविद्यालय में "महाकवि केशव अध्यापन एवं अनुसंधान केन्द्र" की स्थापना सन् 1983 में हुई। आठवीं पंचवर्षीय योजना में इसे विश्वविद्यालय अनुदान आयोग द्वारा "हिन्दी विभाग" का दर्जा प्राप्त हुआ। सन् 1993 से आज तक विभाग में एम.ए., एम.फिल., कक्षाएँ सफलतापूर्वक संचालित हैं तथा बड़ी संख्या में छात्र शोध कार्य कर रहे हैं। विभाग में अनेक मेघावी विद्यार्थी आज कई महत्वपूर्ण पदों पर है। विभाग के एम.ए., पी—एच.डी. छात्र काशी हिन्दू विश्वविद्यालय से लेकर देश के विभिन्न महाविद्यालयों, केन्द्रीय विद्यालयों, नवोदय विद्यालयों में अध्यापक, संस्थानों में हिन्दी अधिकारी आदि हैं। विभाग के विद्यार्थी आई.पी.एस. से लेकर

Provision to watch MOOCs and other Video lectures has been created in the Conference Hall of the department. The students and faculty members are encouraged to register online.

Business Lab: We have established a Business Lab in the department to give exposure and motivation to the students about the latest corporate happenings and to make them aware about the contribution of corporate leaders in the business world. It has a round table sitting of 25 persons extendable to sixty persons. A Smart Board and PCs with WiFi connection and Books on Corporate Leaders and their Biographies, Entrepreneurship, Motivation and related aspects have been made available. Brief profiles of selected corporate leaders and achievers have been displayed in the Business Lab.

Language Lab: We have established a language lab of sitting capacity of 10 students. It is installed with Language learning software and has a WiFi connection. The objective is to polish the communication skills of weak students. We are in the process of further strengthening the Language Lab.

Library & Book Bank: The departmental library has more than 12000 books in our Departmental Library. All the students are provided a book-kit in each semester comprising of at least one book on each subject of the concerned semester at a nominal subscription fee. We also subscribe leading News Papers, Magazines & Journals.

Class Rooms: The department has a Conference Hall, an Activity Hall and five big size Lecture Rooms for teaching & Learning. All the class rooms are well-equipped with Power Point Projectors.

Training & Placement: A well-established Training & Placement Cell of the department takes care of such activities in the campus. Every year we organize Campus Interviews for our students and facilitate the Summer Training & Placement of our students. Prism Johnson Cement, ICICI Bank, Mahindra Finance, HDFC Life, Global Investment are some of the companies that have visited our campus for placement drive in recent past.

Young Executives Club: The Club is a student body making regular contribution to the curricular and co-curricular activities of the institute such as- organising Guest Lectures by eminent personalities from the field of Education and Business, organising Social and Cultural events, organising Business and Industrial tours, preparation and dissemination of instructional material and teaching aids, organising Workshops and Conference/Seminars, organising Management Festivals and maintaining Campus.

Induction Ceremony: As a part of healthy tradition of the department, Induction Ceremony is organized every year in the department. One subject expert and two alumni are invited in the Induction Ceremony. This year, Prof. Shirish Limaye, Retd. Professor, SYMBIOSIS, Pune addressed the freshers as a Subject Expert while Dr. Pranat Kanodia, MBA 2011 alumnus and Mr. Aayush Santhalia, MBA 2017 alumnus addressed the freshers as alumni representatives. The new entrants are made aware of the syllabus, curriculum, attendance requirements, discipline& code of conduct, infrastructuralfacilities, students club, alumni association, management festival etc. They are communicated about the culture and activities of the department for their development.

Management Festival: Management Festivals are organised for the overall development of the students of the department. So far 15 ManagementFestivals have been organized. A Management Festival lasts for 4-5 days and includes 20-25 competitions for the students comprising of Academic, Cultural & Sports Activities & Events. The concept of festival is on the theme: "By the students, of the students and for the students".

Alumni Meet: Four Alumni Meets have been organized by the department in 2004, 2007, 2010 and 2015 at a larger scalein which more than 600 pass out MBA, BBA MPhil & PhD students have participated. Silver Jubilee Alumni Meet of the department was organized in October 2015 in which 268 alumni participated. Further, since last five years a meet of local alumni is organized during the Management Festival in the department, every year.

Alumni Association: AROMA stands for Association of Rewa's Outstanding management Alumni. It is the Alumni Association of the department. AROMA is standing on a strong footing which does regular Charity & Social







Responsibility activities. AROMA Connects all the alumni, teachers & students of the department with each other to create a synergy. Computer Application Centre

The department was established in 1985-86 (erstwhile known as Computer Centre), in the university by the University Grants Commission, New Delhi with the aim of providing job oriented computer courses and employment oriented programs to the students of Vindhya region. In the beginning the department was headed by Prof. S. P. Agrawal, who contributed immensely to its firm establishment and development. Initially ICIM DRS 300 Mini computer System was installed with other peripheral devices including line printers. The established computer centre was upgraded in year 2000 by the UGC. In the year 2017 the University has renamed computer centre as Department of Computer Application. At present department has more than hundred Pentium personal computers, printers and other peripheral devices. The department conducts training programs for university / college teachers, employees and students, besides computing and software development for the university.

Courses Offered

The three year BCA program has been started in the year 2006-2007 on self supporting basis (Ordinance number 120). Looking to the demand of students the University has started Master of Computer Application (MCA) course in the year 2013-14 (Ordinance number 165). The MCA course got approval from AICTE, New Delhi from the session 2015-16. In addition to those 12 short term computer courses are also being offered as per demand of students (Ordinance number 95). There are 271 students enrolled in the department in the current session 2019-20.

National Service Scheme

National Service Scheme (NSS) is a major throb of the university where about twenty thousand students are registered. One hundred and forty two colleges of the university are related to this scheme. There are in total 203 working units. NSS has performed the pious task of planting saplings and trees in the campus. 3845 students have planted about 4000 plants. Outside the campus in about 11 institutions 19 units with 1026 students and teachers have planted 1500 plants. NSS has established the Red Ribbon Club that spreads knowledge regarding AIDS.

NSS organized National Unity Camp at Chitrakoot in which 496 participants came from 14 states of India. We could see India in a miniature at Chitrakoot. Students of different cultural and lingual background worked together, lived together and indulged in thought processes.

During 2010-11 about 120 students of the university participated in different state level camps of NSS. In the Republic Day parade we send our four students on an average every year. In a state level camp organized in Guna, Madhya Pradesh our university achieved the first position in cultural activities. In Andhra Pradesh at a national level camp where about 15 universities participated, our university again received the first position award.

Research Directorate

On the directives of University Grants Commission and Ministry of Human Resource Development, New Delhi, the Research Directorate has been established in the university, for quality assurance of research. The Entrance Test for admission to Ph.D. in different subjects is conducted by the directorate. Thereafter it organizes the Pre-Ph.D. Course Work of six months duration for the successful candidates in different subjects. All the activities concerned with the quality of research in the university are monitored under the supervision of the research directorate.

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)

The IQAC assesses the quality of education in the various teaching departments of the university. The members of the cell evaluate all the activities pertaining to academics which exhibit growth and development of the university under the supervision of the Hon. Vice Chancellor. The IQAC prepares and submits the SSR for assessment to NAAC. The members include The Vice Chancellor, Registrar, DCDC, DSW, nominated professors, one member of Hon. Executive Council of A.P.S.University, two nominees from the local society and an entrepreneur from Rewa.

Alumini Association:

The University has an alumni association that connects the ex-students to the university at an emotional level. From time to time conferences of the alumni are organized. Our ex-students are an inseparable part of our university.

University Library:

Our central library has an impressive building. The central library of the university has about 65 thousand books; out of which five thousand are rare books. In 2010 e-library has been established withthe help of grant provided by UGC. The library runs INFLIBNET. It has soul software. About 10000 research journals are available online. Separate cubical for teachers are available where they can pursue study and research uninterrupted.
